The Margaret King Educational Grant is an educational grant the Society introduced in 2004. This grant is made available to an immediate family member of a person with haemophilia or related bleeding disorder, be it a spouse, son, daughter, sister, brother, mother or father. Carriers with factor levels greater than 40% can also apply for this grant. The person applying must be accepted on a post second level educational course at levels 7 to 9. The person with the bleeding disorder must be registered at the National Coagulation Centre at St. James's Hospital in Dublin. First prize is €2,000, second prize is €1,000 and third prize is €500. Each candidate must provide the I.H.S. with a receipt of payment for their college course at the time of application.
