The Maureen & Jack Downey Educational Grant is an educational grant the Society introduced in the late 1980's. This grant is made available to a person with haemophilia or related bleeding disorder, including a person with carrier status (defined as a person with mild, moderate or severe haemophilia or related bleeding disorder, or defined a carrier with levels ranging from 1% to 40%). The person must have been accepted onto a post second level educational course from level 7 to 9. The person must be registered at the National Coagulation Centre at St. James's Hospital in Dublin. First prize €4,000, second prize is €2,000 and third prize is €1,000. Each candidate must provide the I.H.S. with a receipt of payment for their college course at the time of application.
